

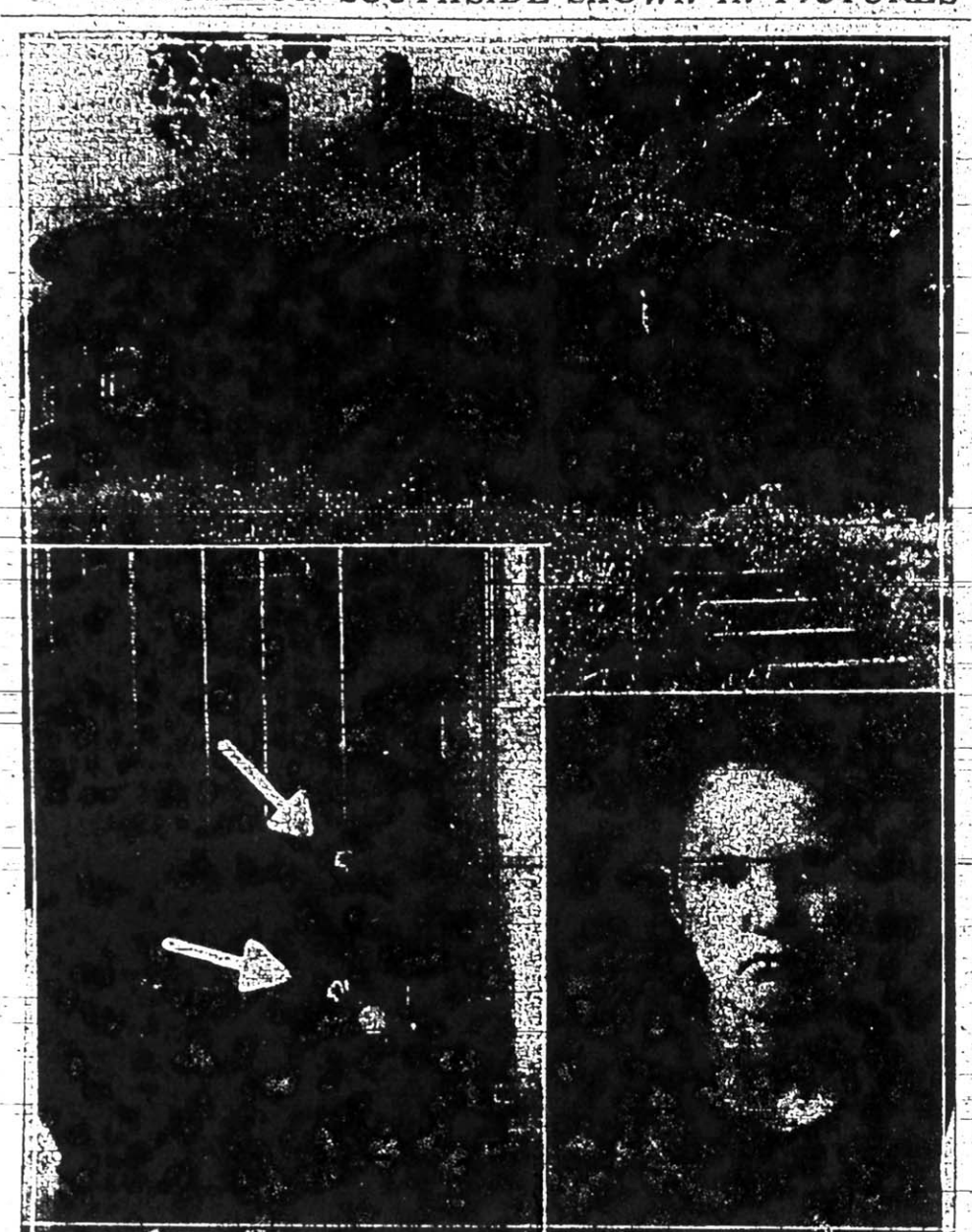

Emerson Wilson, student at North School and formerly a member of the high school paper staff, who shot through a window at Hillman Hospital... Wilson was being held on charges of assault to murder.

Hospital attendants said loss of blood and possibility of infection made the wounds dangerous. Hamer admitted the shooting to Police Officers Coggins and Fulbright and Detectives McGuire and C. E. Baskin.

For an hour or more Wilson had been peering up and down the hall outside our door. He was threatening to hammer down the door.

Wilson was struck by the first bullet in the chest, ran from the room into the hall to find her father walking "directly down the hall about streaming from his arm."
