

## AIR CHAMPIONS TO VISIT WAUSAU

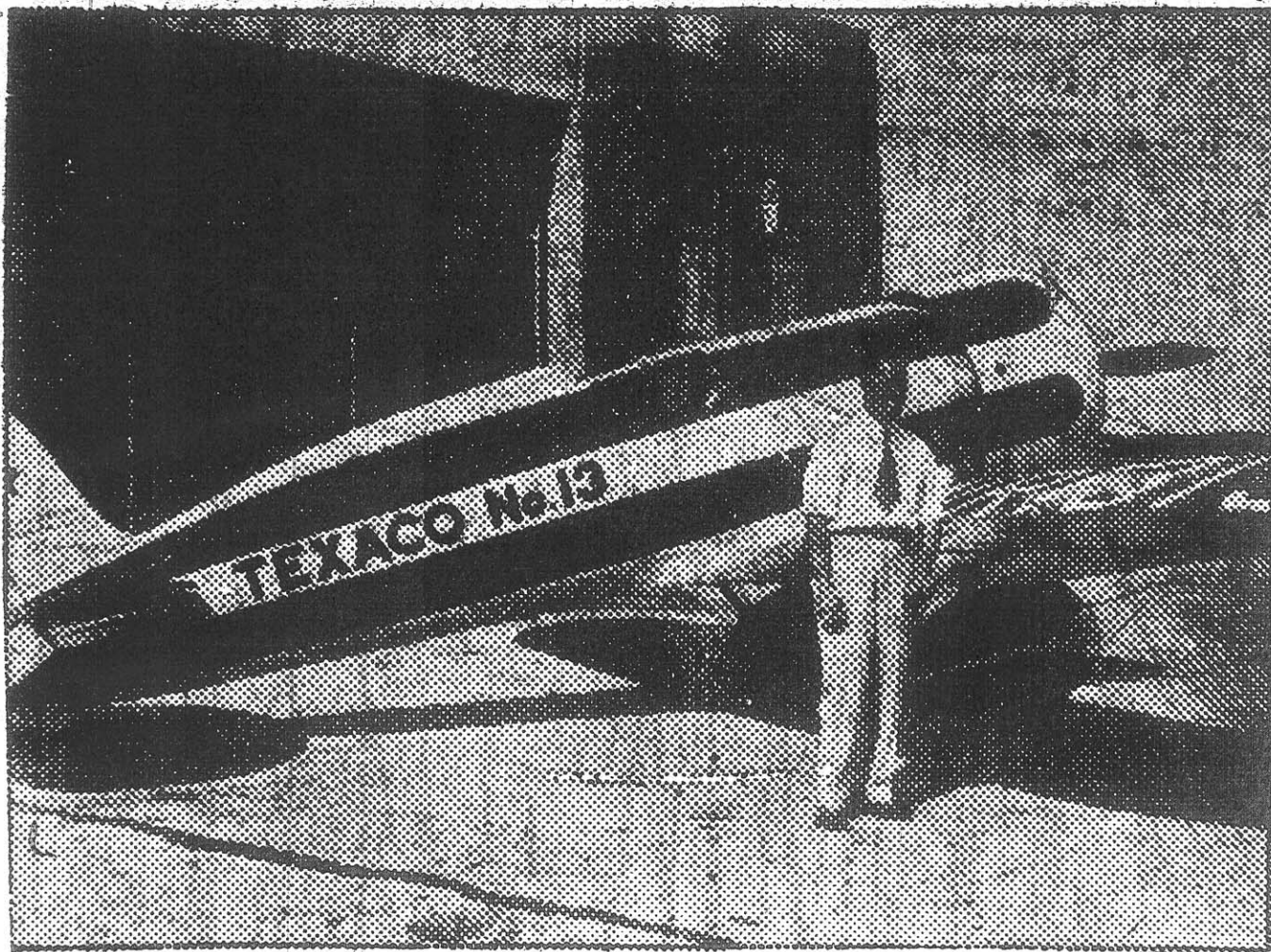
